ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO LIFE

I affirm the principle espoused in our Declaration of Independence: “.....that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.”

We must remember that these inalienable “Rights” are not given to us by the government or the courts. They are inherent rights that belong to each and every Human Being, whether born, unborn, aged or infirm. These inherent rights are at the core of what it means to be a Human Being and to have freedom. These are the absolute rights of Human Beings to live free and enjoy their lives. These rights are not gifts from the government, nor can they be taken away by any foreign or domestic law or court.

By making Abortion the law of the land, the courts of the United States have sanctioned a tool allowing for the most effective and efficient way of taking away one of these inalienable rights, the Right to Life. Abortion is one of the most effective ways of gradually destroying our inalienable rights and freedoms. Individual lives and freedoms are taken away legally every day, one person at a time.

In order to accomplish this, all the U.S. Courts had to do was simply declare that certain classes of Human Beings are not to be considered actual persons and therefore not entitled to the protection of the law. Which class of Human Beings will be next? The government has basically legalized the right of one class of persons to kill another class of persons. STEM CELL RESEARCH:

Supporting Medical research to find cures for debilitating diseases like Alzheimer's and diabetes is critically important. America should do everything in its power to encourage the development of new treatments and drugs to help cure these diseases. I cannot, however, ask American taxpayers to pay for research that intentionally destroys human life, or authorizes the farming or cloning of human embryos, like something out of a science fiction movie.

Embryonic stem cell research is not the only option for stem cell research. Other promising alternatives that do not destroy human life – such as cord blood stem cell research – have shown much promise without the moral and ethical questions that surround embryonic stem cell research.

I support legislation banning the practice of fetal farming, which is the creation of human embryos specifically for the purposes of scientific research, I do, however, support legislation which would direct federal funding to stem-cell research that does not rely on human embryos.

I support “The Sanctity of Human Life Act (HR-4157) submitted in the 110th Congress, or similar legislation, which defines life as beginning with fertilization.
